6. Meeting With DRE Coordinator – NMAC is current for counting ARIDE as NMLEA mandated 4-hour refresher
  - a. NMAC 10.29.7.8 A(4)
    - i. For all officers who may be involved in the arrest of DWI offenders as a normal part of their duties, four (4) hours shall be in NHTSA approved standardized field sobriety testing (SFST) protocols or successful course completion of the NHTSA approved sixteen (16) hour advanced roadside impaired driving enforcement course.

8. 2015 SFST Report Recommendations – Discussion (*Time Permitting*)
  - a. Program Administrative
    - i. Encourage State representation at Administrative License Revocation (ALR) hearings
    - ii. Research and implement alternative methods for witnesses to provide testimony in ALR hearings to increase the efficiency of the ALR process
    - iii. Provide training and oversight for Implied Consent Hearing Officers
    - iv. Include judicial representation on the DWI/SFST Instructor Oversight Committee
    - v. Ensure SFST Coordinator audits ARIDE training and DRE School
    - vi. Include the DRE coordinator on the DWI/SFST Instructor Oversight Committee
  - b. Program Operation
    - i. Implement *Cops in Court* courses to train and prepare officers to testify in DWI cases
    - ii. Adopt a Standardized SFST Report Form
    - iii. Promote ARIDE training to prepare for anticipated increase in drugged-driving incidents and to satisfy the SFST Refresher requirement
  - c. Program Prosecution and Adjudication
    - i. Provide educational opportunities for prosecutors and judges on the SFSTs
    - ii. Develop strategies to pursue the admissibility of HGN as valid and scientific evidence of impairment
